Domaine de Pellehaut is situated at the highest point in the district of Montréal du Gers (180 Metres) and covers 530 hectares of which 180 hectares are vines.

#### **More About This Producer**

The vineyard is situated on the slopes of Chateau de Pellehaut, which benefits from an ideal terroir for vines that have poorer soils and a maximum amount of sunshine.

The Roman villa of Seviac is only 2 kms away and has mosaics featuring vines on its walls, so it is possible that there were vines planted at Pellehaut in Roman times.

It is a traditional farming estate run in a traditional way by Gaston Béraut and his sons, Martin and Mathieu. The vines are only situated on the slopes, with the low land being reserved for cattle and crops. The straw from the local "Blonde d'Aquitaine" cattle sheds makes a first-rate manure for the vines, thus allowing a balance of organic matter to be maintained in the different parcels, whilst limiting the use of synthetic fertilizer.
