VARIETAL PERCENTAGE: *85% Sauvignon Blanc, 15% Sauvignon Musque*

AGE OF VINES AND SOIL TYPE: *Uboldi Vineyards, Kenwood, CA: 18 year old vines planted in rocky soils at a 400' elevation.*

DATE PICKED: *Sauvignon Blanc: 9/27/2013*

HARVEST SUGAR: *24.4 degrees Brix*

FERMENTATION TIME/TEMPERATURE RANGE: *48 days, 52-60.*

FERMENTATION CONTAINER/AGING: *Barrel fermented in 3-8 year old French oak. No malolactic fermentation. Aged surlies for 4 months. Stirred twice a week.*

VINTAGE AND WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

This is our thirteenth release of Sauvignon Blanc from Uboldi Vineyards in Kenwood, CA. The aromatics of this wine blend a broad spectrum of lemon, lime, and green apples to passion fruit. These fruit characters are very present in the mouth, accompanying a very crisp finish with a long, round lingering finish. The acidity of this wine makes it refreshing and food friendly. This wine is best served between 52 and 58 degrees F (an average refrigerator after two hours).
