The winemaker, Alain Combard has a strong passion for the land which he has developed for over 40 years in Chablis and Provence. TASTING NOTES

A salmon pink hue. Flattering bouquet of citrus fruits and red fruit. Fresh and smooth on the palate, evoking the juiciness of apricots and grapefruit.

VINEYARD

Côtes de Provence - The land is composed mainly of schist, formed by the re-crystallization of a clay-based sedimentary rock due to high heat and pressure in the earth's crust. Ranging from silver-gray to golden ochre in color, it breaks in thin layers, which produces a fine, flaky soil. domaine covers 65 hectares (160 acres) and is surrounded by forests of pine, cork oak, and eucalyptus.
