2012 ROSÉ

WASHINGTON STATE - YAKIMA VALEY

Our 2012 Dry Rosé is produced from 100% Lemberger from the Crawford Vineyard in the Yakima Valley. This wine is extremely aromatic with aromas of raspberries and honeydew melon and a dry, crisp finish.

For every bottle sold, Thurston Wolfe donates \$1 to our local pet rescue program where we found our winery dog, Chance.



2012 PGV (PINOT GRIS & VIOGNIER)

WASHINGTON STATE WHITE TABLE WINE

Our 2012 PGV is Thurston Wolfe's unique blend of 63% Pinot Gris, 34% Viognier, and 3% Orange Muscat creating a rare wine with intense fruit aromas and a rich, crisp finish. Enjoy with chicken recipes, steamed mussels, clam linguini and other seafood dishes or by itself on the patio with good friends.



2011 D.R. WOLFE'S FAMILY RED

WASHINGTON STATE RED TABLE WINE

The 2011 D.R. Wolfe's Family Red is a unique blend of Zinfandel (55%), Petite Sirah (25%), Lemberger (20%), all grown in the Horse Heaven Hills of Washington State. Soft, fruity and full-bodied, this wine complements a wide range of rich and hardy dishes and is meant for enjoyment now through 2022.



2012 VIOGNIER

WASHINGTON STATE - HORSE HEAVEN HILLS

This is our second 100% Viognier and is produced from the Zephyr Ridge Vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills. Harvested in early October, it was stainless fermented to maximize the intense peach, pear and apricot aromas characteristic of this variety. Enjoy with roasted chicken, steamed mussels, clam linguini and other seafood dishes. 120 cases produced.

2011 HOWLING WOLFE ZINFANDEL

WASHINGTON STATE - HORSE HEAVEN HILLS

The 2011 Howling Wolfe Zinfandel is our 11th vintage from the Zephyr Ridge Vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills. Harvested in early October, the wine was fermented to dryness on the skins and aged in a mixture of American and European oak for 14 months before bottling in December 2012. Enjoy now with prime rib, rack of lamb or port-glazed pork loin or age through 2021.

2011 THE SPANIARD

WASHINGTON STATE - COLUMBIA VALLEY

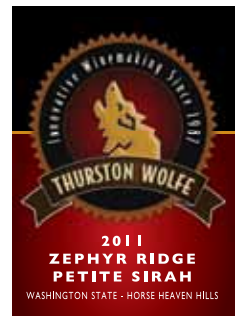
The Spaniard is Thurston Wolfe's fourth bottling of our exciting Mediterranean-style blend of Grenache (63%), Tempranillo (25%), and Syrah (12%). Grenache and Tempranillo are the primary red varieties of the Rioja region of Spain. Following fermentation and blending, the wine was aged in French and American oak for 16 months before bottling. Only 198 cases produced!



2011 ZEPHYR RIDGE PETITE SIRAH

WASHINGTON STATE - HORSE HEAVEN HILLS

Our 2011 Petite Sirah is produced from grapes grown at the Zephyr Ridge Vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills. It was fermented dry and aged 20 months in French and American oak before bottling. Smoke, white pepper and oak spice aromas and intense richness and full body characterize this rare wine for Washington State. 420 cases produced.



2011 BURGESS VINEYARD SYRAH

WASHINGTON STATE - COLUMBIA VALLEY

Our 2011 Syrah is produced from the Burgess Vineyard, the source of our first Syrah wine in 1995. Harvested in mid October, it was aged 18 months in American and French oak before bottling. Dark fruit and spice aromas with soft rich tannins make this wine enjoyable now through 2020.

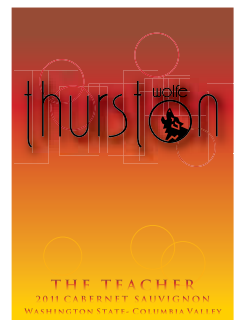


THE TEACHER · 2011 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Our 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon is our sixth dedication to Stan Clarke, renowned Washington State viticulturist, teacher and mentor of students of all ages. His favorite wine was Cabernet Sauvignon. Please enjoy this wine anytime, but especially in memory of Stan on its 10th anniversary in 2021.

The 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend from select vineyards in the Columbia Valley. Following aging in French and American oak for 14 months, the wine was bottled in January 2013. With intense cherry, cassis, mocha and oak spice aromas and rich, full flavors, this wine can be enjoyed now or aged through 2022.

2011 TEMPRANILLO

WASHINGTON STATE - YAKIMA VALLEY

Tempranillo, the best known of the Spanish red varieties, is an exciting new variety for Washington State. Our fifth release is 100% Tempranillo from the Crawford Vineyard in the Yakima Valley. Aged in French and American oak for 18 months before bottling. Enjoy now and through 2022. Only 49 cases produced and selected for our wine club.



2011 CABERNET FRANC

WASHINGTON STATE - COLUMBIA VALLEY

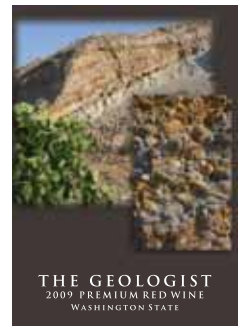
Our 2011 Cabernet Franc is from the Burgess Vineyard near Pasco WA. Harvested in late October, the wine was aged in American oak for 18 months before bottling. Enjoy now or age through 2020. Only 48 cases produced and selected for our wine club.



2009 THE GEOLOGIST PREMIUM RED WINE

WASHINGTON STATE - COLUMBIA VALLEY

The Geologist was inspired by the dramatic volcanic and fluvial geology of eastern Washington's viticulture regions. Our front label shows a key component, the Snipes Mountain growing area, with its unique ancestral Columbia River conglomerate soils directly overlying ancient weathered basalt. The Geologist captures in the bottle this viticultural legacy as well as recognizing the professional inspiration of one of our family members; geoscientist, Michael Yeaman. Aged 23 months in French and American oak and 2 years in the bottle before release. Limited production of 120 cases.

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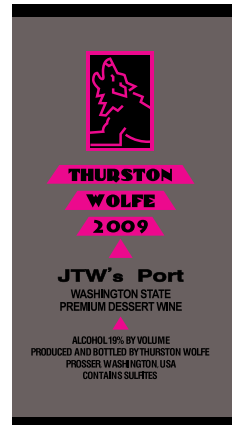

2009 JTW's PORT

WASHINGTON STATE - COLUMBIA VALLEY

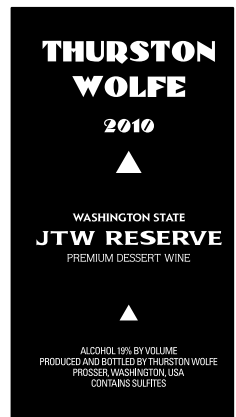
Our 2009 JTW's Port is a blend of Touriga Nacional (39%) from the Lonesome Spring Vineyard in the Yakima Valley, Petite Sirah (32%) from the Zephyr Ridge Vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills and Cabernet Sauvignon (29%) from the Crawford Vineyard in the Yakima Valley. Descriptors: Black cherry, boysenberry, chocolate, spice and black pepper. Enjoy with anything chocolate, Stilton cheese and Bartlett pears, or curled up next to a winter fire.



2010 JTW RESERVE PORT

WASHINGTON STATE - COLUMBIA VALLEY

Our 2010 JTW Reserve is a blend of three traditional Portuguese port varieties in equal proportions. The varieties include Touriga Nacional from the Lonesome Spring Vineyard in the Yakima Valley and Tinta Cao and Souzao from the Upland Vineyard on Snipes Mountain. Featuring a deep garnet color, the aroma is chocolate, plum, black cherry, coffee and spice. 100 cases of 375ml bottles produced and sold exclusively from the winery and select retail accounts.

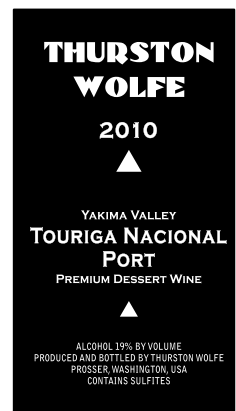


2010 TOURIGA NACIONAL PORT

WASHINGTON STATE - YAKIMA VALLEY

We traditionally use Touriga Nacional grapes as the core varietal in our JTW port blend. However, because of the intensity of the 2010 vintage we choose to hold back one barrel of Touriga and bottle it as a single varietal port. The 2010 vintage is 100% Touriga Nacional from the Lonesome Spring Vineyard in the Yakima Valley. Only 50 cases of 375ml bottles produced and sold exclusively from the winery and select retail accounts.

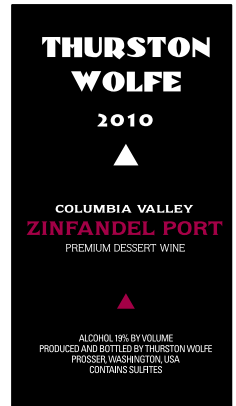

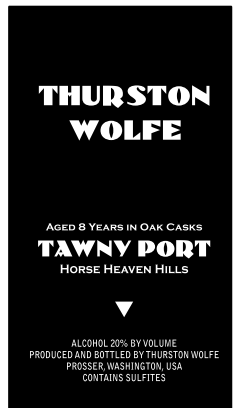
2010 ZINFANDEL PORT WASHINGTON STATE - COLUMBIA VALLEY

On rare occasions we produce a Zinfandel port when the fruit is of exceptional quality. The 2010 vintage of Zinfandel Port is 100% Zinfandel from the Zephyr Ridge Vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills. Harvested in late September at 28 Brix, the grapes were fermented in a small open-top fermenter. Midway through fermentation, grape brandy was added and the wine was allowed to macerate on skins six days before pressing to maximize color and flavor extraction. After barrel aging 26 months, the wine was bottled in December 2012. Enjoy with anything chocolate, Marion Berry pie or by itself. Only 50 cases of 375ml bottles were produced! It is sold exclusively from the winery and very select retail accounts.



TAWNY PORT WASHINGTON STATE - HORSE HEAVEN HILLS

Thurston Wolfe is proud to announce the release of our first eight year old Tawny Port. In 2005 we reserved four barrels of Zinfandel port from the Zephyr Ridge vineyard for this project. The wine was stored outside at the winery to expose it to the extremes of weather without topping. At the end of eight years the wine was concentrated down to three barrels and it was designated ready for bottling. Dark tawny in color with a ruby hue from the Zinfandel, the wine is redolent of figs, butterscotch, caramel, vanilla bean and Madeira with flavors of cherry liqueur, roasted almonds and plum preserves. Perfect by itself or with your favorite chocolate desserts, pecan pie or Turkish coffee with chocolate curls gelato. Fifty cases of 375ml bottles produced, released November 2013 and sold only at the winery and select retail accounts.



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
