The wines of Bois du Boursan are a result of a knowledge of several generations combined with a faith in the vineyard cultivated with scrupulous concern for the environment.

**More About This Producer**

Bois de Boursan was founded in 1955 by Jean Versino and is now run by his son, Jean-Paul. It is a ten-hectare domaine situated in the village of Chateauneuf-du-Pape. Working all of the permitted thirteen grape varieties for the appellation, the Versino family manages twenty-seven separate parcels of vineyards. The average age of the vines is in excess of fifty years. The domaine is worked organically without the use of chemical fertilizers or pesticides. Further, the vinification is traditional to its core: the grapes for the red are not de-stemmed, the cuvaion extends for at least three weeks in wood of barrels of varying size and aged eighteen months or longer. The wines, both red and white, are ageworthy.
