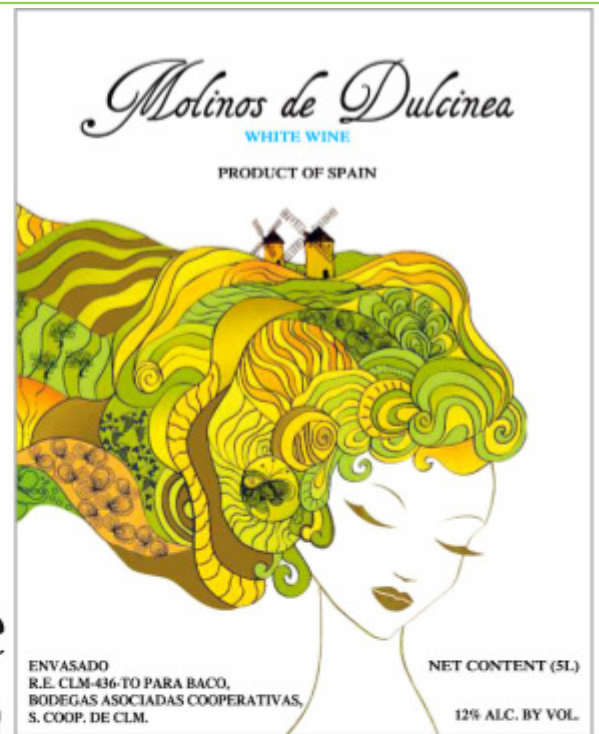


# Molinos de Dulcinea White

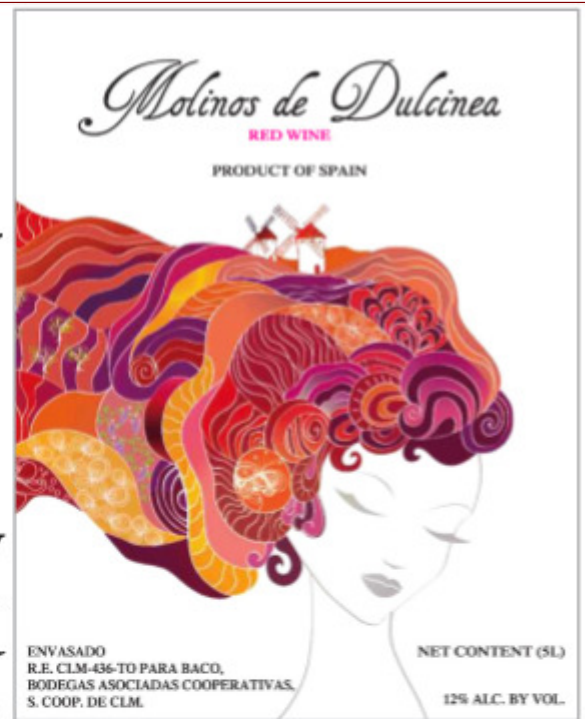
