Vintage Details

The 2013 growing season was a pleasant and normal year overall, with some winter rain. “Early, even, and excellent” are the words used by the Napa Valley Vintners Association, giving consistent quality and predictable harvest numbers. Spring was warm and dry, bringing bud break along early, and canopies sprang up rapidly. Flowering and fruit set looked great and cluster counts looked normal or a bit higher. One major hot spell in late June and early July was hard on a few vineyards that had done a lot of leaf pulling, but nice even weather in Sept allowed for a lot of hang time and concentration.

Oak Aging

30 Months, 90% New French Oak

Tasting Notes

The nose exhibits dark blueberry jam and sweet caramel vanilla oak. Nicely balanced on the palate, with slight acidity in the mid palate and gentle tannins. Beautiful cherry flavors and serious attitude!
