



Vineyard first planted End of 18th century

Total area 5.5 hectares (13.6 acres)

Situation

Down the southern slope of Saint Emilion

Soil types Calcareous and siliceous clay

Planting density 6,600 vines per hectare

Average age of vines 40 years

Cultivation
Traditional with bud removal, thinning out,
elimination of some green fruit

Soil management Grass cover crop

> Yield 35 to 40 hectolitres per hectare

> > Harvesting Manual

Fruit selection
On a Mistral vibrating sorting table

Vatting

3 to 4 weeks in stainless steel tanks with temperature control. Tanks filled using a peristaltic pump

Winemaking

Fruit from individual plots is processed in stainless steel tanks with temperature control and wooden vats.

Gentle extraction achieved by breaking up cap and stirring

Ageing

One third in stainless steel tanks, another third in new barrels, final third in one-year-old barrels for 18 to 20 months

Annual production 25,000 bottles
